There was once a captain of a dock ship who lost his position because he felt he must keep the seventh-day Sabbath. The day came when there was nothing in the house for his children to eat. The mother cried, and little Elizabeth asked what was the matter.

Her mother explained the situation to her as best she could. Then the little girl showed the faith in God which is the secret of happiness in adversity. She said, "Why, mamma, we have not had our morning worship yet. Why are you crying before we have asked God for food?"

So together they prayed the Lord's Prayer, "Give us this day our daily bread." As they finished, there was a knock at the back door. When the mother opened the door, she found a new neighbor there with a quantity of food. Somewhat embarrassed, she explained her errand. She said that she had a friend who was employed at the royal house. There had been a banquet there the evening before, and her friend had brought her more of the food that had been left over than she herself could use. So she wanted to know if her neighbor could not help her out by taking some.

Of course she did, and Elizabeth remarked, "Mamma, we asked God for our daily bread, and He has sent it to us from the queen's own table!" Thus it is often that in faith in God "a little child shall lead them." –
